Funding available in Lincoln to support residents

Energy Bills Support Scheme doubled to a one-off £400

Eligible households will get £400 of support with their energy bills through an expansion of the Energy Bills Support Scheme.

£650 one-off Cost of Living Payment for those on means tested benefits

Eligible households on means tested benefits will receive a payment of £650 this year, made in two instalments.

One-off £300 Pensioner Cost of Living Payment

Pensioner households will receive an extra £300 this year to help them cover the rising cost of energy this winter.

£150 Disability Cost of Living Payment

Eligible residents on disability benefits will receive a one-off payment of £150 from September.

£500m increase and extension of Household Support Fund

The Government is providing an extra £500 million of local support, via the Household Support Fund, which will be extended from this October to March 2023.
