<p>13) Whilst the premises are open for business and have a DJ operating, a planned event or a promotional evening or when the premises plan to trade between 0230 to 0400 hours, there shall be a minimum number of 2 SIA-registered door supervisors on duty at the entrance of the premises from 2200hrs for the first 200 customers and an additional door supervisor for each 100 extra customers or part thereof whilst the premises is open for business and such ratios remain until 15 minutes after closing.</p> <p>14) On all other days not identified in the above condition, the number of door supervisors and times when they are deployed shall be identified by way of a Risk Assessment completed by the Designated Premises Supervisor or advice from Lincolnshire Police.</p>	<p>A, Whenever open beyond midnight and every Friday and Saturday Night –There shall be on duty, from 22:00 hrs a minimum of 2 SIA registered door staff on the door and a minimum of 1 SIA registered door staff inside the premises up to the first 100 customers and an additional one for every 100 customers thereafter.</p> <p>B, On any other night door supervisors shall be provided in such numbers as the Licence Holder considers necessary for the keeping of order on the premises when used for Licensable Activities.</p>	<p>11. There shall be a minimum number of 2 SIA-registered door supervisors on duty at the entrance of the premises from 22:00hrs whilst it is open for business and until 15 minutes after closing.</p> <p>12. There shall be 1 additional SIA registered door supervisor on duty at the premises from 22:00hrs for the first 100 customers and for each 100 extra customers or part thereof whilst the premises are open for business and until 15 minutes after closing.</p>
