Just wanted to offer some thoughts on the policy on behalf of Lincs Police. I've bullet pointed below some areas for your consideration:

**2.9 (page 5)** Could you also include immigration/modern day slavery/trafficking?

**5.5.11 (page 18)** Could you include the consequences of a failed TP or indicate that such matters would be treated seriously by the authority/committee?

**8.2 (page 23)** This section appears to slightly contradict paragraph 5 on page 37. I read this section as though a hearing would still be required although the later reference on page 37 suggests that no hearing is required. Can you clarify? Are you saying that a hearing is not required if all parties are in agreement with new conditions, however, changes will only be adopted if the police/responsible authority submit a rep?

**8.10 (page 24)** Will conditions also be published online and updated at regular intervals for ease of use/reference by applicants?

**10.3 (page 30)** Please could persistent sales of alcohol to a minor be included in this section?

Please come back to me if you have any questions although I think from our previous discussion you understand the above points we've raised.
